

APPLICATION FOR GRANT TO ASSIST IN OBTAINING AN OUT OF PROVINCE JUDGE

[Motion passed at the 2017 AGM]

The Association has set aside a maximum of \$3500 for the 2018 event years for either a field trial or hunt test club to apply for a one time grant of \$700 to bring in an out-of-province national or similarly qualified judge. This would mean one \$700 grant per club per event type. If applications exceed \$3500, an executive decision will be made.

Note: If the proposed judge is not a recent National Judge a brief statement as to why he or she should be considered as being "similarly qualified" is to be set out below.
