

EVENT GRANT

Each club holding a CKC Field Trial or Hunt Test incorporating one All-Age, Qualifying and Junior stake or one Master, Senior and Junior test shall be entitled to one \$250 grant in the year, payable upon providing the secretary with the required marked catalogue and running dog fees following that event.

LAND AID GRANT

On application by a member club, the Association – subject to the conditions set out below being met to the satisfaction of the Executive – may grant 50% of the cost of rental equipment with a maximum grant of \$2,000 to assist clubs in improving grounds used by them for trials/hunt tests and for training purposes.

Receipts must accompany cost of the rental equipment.

Conditions to be met are:

There is to be provided to the satisfaction of the Executive:

1. a copy of signed, written agreement with the land owner allowing use of the lands and allowing for an extension into future years, together with a description of what uses are to be allowed and any restrictions or uses by other persons or organizations.
2. a full description of the improvement for which the equipment is required and a brief summary of the reason for the improvement, together with updates or any variations during the preparation and construction period.
3. a brief summary of past work and expenditures on development of the property.
4. an assurance of the availability of the balance of the cost of equipment rental not covered by the grant is to be provided prior to advance of any portion of the grant.
5. at executive discretion depending on fund availability.

JUDGE SEMINAR GRANT

The executive may exercise discretion in approving the application for a grant of \$500 for activities that apply to education in retriever training and judging in field trials and hunt tests.

JUDGE GRANT

To set aside a maximum of \$3,500 for the 2018 event year for either a field trial or hunt test club to apply for a one time grant of \$700 to bring in an out of province national or similarly qualified judge. One grant per club per event type. If applications exceed \$3,500, an executive decision will be made. **Receipts re judge's expenses must accompany this application.**

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

Any club lacking funds to cover licensed field trial or hunt test expenses may apply for a grant of up to \$500 by providing a summary of their financial circumstances in addition to a trial or test budget. This grant is to be repaid from any net profits from the event.
